2010 Arizona State School Tax Credit Contribution

I am enclosing a (_____ check, _____ cash, _____ money order) for \$ _____ as a contribution to the public school system for extracurricular activities or character education programs. This contribution can be used to reduce my Arizona State Income Tax liability to as much as zero, on Arizona Form 322. This is a direct tax reduction and does not require filling out a long form to get the reduction. For single taxpayers or heads of household, the credit cannot exceed \$200. For married taxpayers that file a joint return, the credit cannot exceed \$400. If married taxpayers file separate returns, each spouse may claim 1/2 of the credit that would have been allowed on a joint return.

By law the money must be spent by the school for extracurricular activities – A.R.S. 43-1089-01. Generally, any educational or recreational activities that supplement the educational program of the school are considered to be extracurricular activities.
